Sharing patient data with World Courier for Direct-to-Patient logistics

Project setup.



Process for the exchange of patient data agreed and documented.

A Transport Management System (TMS) account is set up with project instructions. **Process to initiate** shipment agreed.

The order is placed.



Patient data is securely shared with World Courier, electronically or by phone.

World Courier only requires essential details to initiate the shipment. Data is received and processed for the sole purpose of coordinating, picking up and delivering shipments.

How World Courier continues to protect patient data

Access to data is restricted to World **Courier associates** who are authorized and require the information to do their jobs.

The patient's address details are limited to the destination city.

The patient's name is not entered in the standard name field.

Shipment processing.



TMS processes all order details, including patient data, for World Courier's internal operations.

Names are not used on shipping documents to protect patient identity.



Destination city is entered into the address field.

Customs documentation that requires patient details is removed prior to delivering shipments to blinded organizations.

Patient ID rather than name is used for proof of delivery.

Data is processed in a manner that does not allow search of shipment records by patient name.



Secure delivery complete. **Clinical trial regulations**

in a secure data warehouse

Supply chain of custody/security requirements.



Out for shipment

Patient identity is protected from the shipment leaving the pharmacy to delivery.
